EPILOGI CHILDREN'S CHOIR

EPILOGI Children's choir was founded in 1996. The Choir now works in two sections (children's choir and musical workshop) and has about 100 members between the ages of 7 and 16.

The Choir has participated in various choir festivals and musical events both in Cyprus and abroad. They had a number of concerts in Italy and in Greece (Zakinthos, Rhodes, and at Herod Atticus Amphitheatre in Athens).

In June 2005, the Choir takes part in the Kodály Zoltán International Festival of Children's Choirs of Komló, Hungary, and in 2006 in the International Choir Festival "Cantemus" in Zrenjanin, Serbia. In December 2006 the EPILOGI Children's Choir represented Cyprus at the European Christmas festival "Noel in Alsace" in Strasbourg, France.

The choir's repertory includes pieces from the classical repertory from the Renaissance until the 20^{th} century, works of contemporary Greek and Cypriot composers, as well as choral arrangements of traditional songs.

It is a member of the European Choral Union EUROPA CANTAT.

EPILOGI YOUTH CHOIR

The recently established Mixed Youth Choir of EPILOGI Cultural Movement, Limassol is composed of 40 young people between the ages of 14 and 20, the majority of which had been members of EPILOGI Children's Choir.

The repertory of the choir is similar to the one of the Children's choir. This year the Choir has been preparing to participate in various cultural events and festivals in Cyprus and abroad.

"EPILOGI" MIXED CHOIR

The Mixed Choir of EPILOGI Cultural Movement was founded in March of 2000. At present it has about 40 members. As from September of 2003 the conductor of the Choir is Nenad Bogdanovic.

EPILOGI Mixed Choir has taken part in several cultural events and festivals in Cyprus and in Greece, as well (Drama 2001, Rhodes 2004, Preveza 2005 and Alexandria Imathias in 2007). The Choir had performances with a number of renowned choirs, such as the mixed choir of Preveza "Armonia" which had been many times awarded in international choir competitions, the Female Vocal Ensemble of Patra, as well as "Viadana" Chamber Choir of Hungary.

BIOGRAPHY OF MRS. ANGELINA NICOLAIDOU-SPANOU, CONDUCTOR OF THE CHILDREN'S CHOIR AND THE YOUTH CHOIR OF EPILOGI CULTURAL MOVEMENT, LIMASSOL

She graduated at the Liszt Ferenc Academy of Music in Debrecen, Hungary from the class of Sándor Berkesi (conducting) and Zsolt Szesztay (theory), with a degree in music pedagogy, theory, singing and music teaching and choir conducting.

Since 1995 she has been working in Limassol as a secondary school teacher of music, as well as a school choir and orchestra conductor, taking part in several concerts in Cyprus and representing the Cyprus Ministry of Education and the Limassol Municipality in various events in Athens, Greece (December 2002, August 2004, May 2006).

She has lectured in seminars of the Cyprus Ministry of Education and the Pedagogical Institute in choir conducting.

She has taken the lead of the Epilogi Children's Choir in November 2003, which has later divided in two choirs (children's and girls'). She has recently established and conducts the Epilogi Mixed Youth Choir.
