Kamea Dance Company

Kamea was established in Beer-Sheba Israel in 2002 as a professional repertory modern dance company in affiliation with the prestigious Bat-Dor Beer-Sheeva Municipal Dance Center. Founded and co-directed by Daniella Schapria, director of the Beer-Sheva Dance Center, and Tamir Ginz, former Bat-Sheva Dance Co. dancer and Bat-Dor Tel Aviv Co. in-house choreographer. Kamea performs works by Ginz as well as by guest choreographers.

The company's repertoire brings to the stage the diverse work of its choreographers, mainly Israeli who have created works geared to different age groups. The dance pieces encompass a wide range of dance styles and are performed on a high technical and artistic level by Kamea's dancers.
